1902 St. Peter's School extended.



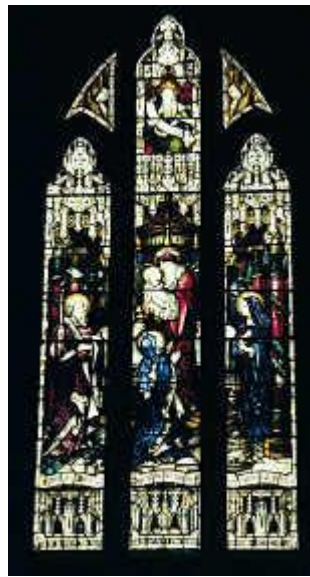
1910-1934 Fr. M Fennell Parish Priest



1912 Four Patron Saints added to Rood Screen.

1912 Statue of St. Peter erected over the Church entrance.

1912 – 1913 Stained Glass windows added to Aisle (made by Hardiman of Birmingham).



1921 St. Peter's chair re-founded

1926 Mosaic Stations of the Cross erected.

1926 Six dormer windows added to give more light into the ceiling area.



1928 - 1929 St. Peter's School rebuilt at a cost of £11,000.

1829 Beatification of John Lloyd and Phillip Evans who had been martyred on 22nd July 1679 at the junction of City Road and Crwys Road. Stained glass window erected in honour of the martyrs.

1931 Parish had 6 priests Fr's J. McGinn, A. Donnelly, H.H. Holman, T. Nunan, J. M. Cronin, M. Fennell:



1932 Fr Holman revives St. Peter's (Marquis of Bute's Own) Boy Scouts.

1937 Bedford Street Hall obtained for the use of the Scouts.



1935-1947 Fr. J. Hurley Parish Priest

1939-1945 Church bombed during WW2 with incendiaries - much damage done to Lady Chapel Roof .

1941 St. David's Cathedral gutted in Blitz. St. Peter's Church chosen by the Archbishop for pontifical functions (1941-1945).

1947-1953 H.H. Holman Parish Priest.
